

Sean Warkentine, a Digital Audio Arts student at University of Lethbridge, is the production coordinator at CKXU 88.3 FM and has been involved in numerous productions including documentaries, live recordings, ads, and more. Under the name An Ant And An Atom, his music has been well received nationally on Earshot electronic charts.

'Something To Write Home About' is a radio show hosted by Sean Warkentine (of the electronic project, An Ant And An Atom) and Adrian Sutherland (of postrock duo, Clockwork Towns, and punk band, Advertisement). The focus of the show is to give exposure to the fringes and more experimental side of all genres of music in an eclectic mix. Due to this, STWHA gives regular airplay to many experimental artists that receive few other opportunities to be heard on the radio in the area. Once a month, when possible, they also convene with another local artist, of any musical background, to create improvised noise and drone music for 30 mins of the hour-long show, which they number as "dossiers." These are aired live and have featured other artists from a variety of musical acts and backgrounds alongside them. The excerpt submitted here featured one such live recording from the summer of 2013, with Adrian on guitar and Sean on computer processing, creating a lovely swirl of ambience. It was these special occasions by which the show was chosen as the best specialty programming for 2013-2014 in recent listener polls.
