

“Sam Returns to History Maker”

British Columbia is quickly becoming one of the most Godless places in the world. As less and less of its residents call themselves Christians, the Pentecostal church struggles to keep its young people in the fold. In this hour-long, sound-rich radio documentary, Sam Fenn and Gordon Katic explore History Maker, a charismatic Christian festival for teenagers held annually in Chilliwack. Can Canada’s Pentecostals inspire these young people into a life of faith? Or will they be seduced away by modernity?
