Timothy Tweed is a producer and host of the music shows “Undercover” and “Sounds from the Tenacious Hi-Fi” as well as the spoken word program “Arts on the Radio”. In November 2013, he was awarded “Programmer of the Year” at PCR’s inaugural “Radio Active” awards.

Program Description

Undercover

“Undercover” is a musical series that explores various covers and interpretations of familiar songs, in a wide variety of genres. The series also occasionally highlights particular artists & bands, as well as historical figures or events that have had a profound influence on subsequent generations of musicians.

Undercover: Ep. 013 (I Have a Dream) is an episode that commemorates the 50th anniversary of Dr. Martin Luther King’s historic “I Have a Dream” speech, given on August 28, 1963 during “The March on Washington for Jobs and Freedom”.

The music in the episode explores the legacy of Dr. King, and the profound impact and influence his words and deeds had on the music of his period, as well as the influence that can still be felt to this day.

The episode aired on Peach City Radio’s online stream the week of August 22, 2013, to coincide with the 50th anniversary of Dr. King’s historic speech.
