About the program:

Radyo Migrante has a spoken word format and works towards being the preeminent radio source of alternative news and progressive commentary on Filipino issues here in Canada and in the Philippines. Our target audience are Filipinos that are interested in social and environmental justice and progressive advances for Filipino peoples everywhere. Radyo Migrante airs every Sunday from 9-10pm.

The year 2013 was a banner year as the show came out with a newscast and "Pulsong Migrante" segment. Also, it has been honoured to have received the Spoken Word Programming Award during the CHRY 25th Anniversary Awards Ceremony on July 6, 2013. This award recognizes the show for "being an outstanding leader in critically thought out spoken word broadcasting" in the York University radio station.

Currently, the radio collective is comprised of Rhea Gamana, Ysh Cabana, Petronila Cleto, Lui Queano and Mary Parreno.

Radyo Migrante's program segments are mostly news, current affairs and news analysis. The talk show is continued to be anchored by active migrant community organizers.
