Dan Dowhal is a Yukon-based writer, educator, and independent producer. Born and raised in Toronto's Queen West neighbourhood, he studied both engineering and journalism at Ryerson University. He has published two novels, *Skyfisher* and *Flam Grub*, and currently makes his home in Dawson City, where he is actively involved in the arts and media scenes.

1-2 Sentence description of the show: Les Dawsoniens is a profile and history of the Francophones of Dawson City, Yukon.

Longer description of show/content:

Francophones have been present in the Yukon ever since first contact was made with the territory's aboriginal peoples. When the Klondike Gold Rush brought tens of thousands of fortune seekers to the region, and led to the founding of Dawson City, French-Canadians were in the forefront, and remained to become a key part of the fabric of town life. Today, the Yukon is one of Canada's most bilingual regions and a new wave of émigrés has arrived, drawn by opportunity, the unspoiled wilderness, and the accepting, egalitarian spirit of Dawson itself. These Francophones — les Dawsoniens — form a vibrant community that celebrates its language and heritage while still integrating into the mainstream of town life. Through interviews and commentary this documentary looks at the past, present, and future of Les Dawsoniens.
