The podcast first saw the light of day in the fall semester 2009. It was a total collaborative effort, from the concept of the show, to the name, to the choosing of music and items each week.

The students come from two Journalism programs at Humber – the three-year program for students with high school diplomas, and the two-year post-graduate program for students with university degrees or college diplomas. They all come together in their final year of students in Advanced Radio News.

One of the challenges of creating a podcast as opposed to a radio show is the difference between broadcasting material and distributing it. Therefore the students found and used music found exclusively on Creative Commons ([www.creativecommons.ca](http://www.creativecommons.ca)).
