The Montreal Sessions is a show produced by a new local artist-in-residence each month. The program focuses on the exploration of the city's excellent and diverse music community. In the past year the CKUT Music Department has invited such groundbreaking musicians, festivals, record labels as Pop Montreal, Suoni Per Il Popolo, MUTEK, Mikey Heppner (Priestess, Uncle Bad Touch), Fixture Records (Dirty Beaches, Omon Ra, Bernardino Femminielli), Katie Lee (BRAIDS), Cadence Weapon, Vergil Sharkya, Natasha Pickowicz (Popcorn Youth), Jordan Cramer (Magic Weapon, Sunset Rubdown), GMACKRR and more.

Program

The Montreal Sessions is a show produced by a new artist-in-residence each month. The show dramatically increases community access to CKUT's airwaves as it provides an opportunity for local independent artists and musicians to create and dictate their own creative exploration of Montreal's music scene. The Montreal Sessions provides CKUT listeners with an opportunity to hear unique live performances and garner information about local musical subcultures and movements. Many of the sessions have been recorded and shared on the [Free Music Archive](#), a curated repository of excellent, free recordings, of which CKUT is a curator.
