The show was soon picked up by CFUV in Victoria as well as CHMA in Sackville which the hosts are incredibly excited about and hope to have the show air on many different stations across Canada. The show will continue to focus on bands from Ottawa to help get the word out to the rest of Canada but will also continue to stay relevant to people outside of Ottawa by interview the movers and shakers in all cities so that we all get to hear their CITY SLANG.
