Third Language Category(Persian) Interview with MS. Cobra Pars, Mr. Babae's wife upon his

imprisonment

Interview with Ms. Cobra Parsa in Iran on January 25, 2014 about the situation of her husband: Mr. Hamid Babaei a PHD student at Leige, Belgium who came with his wife to Iran to visit his family and got arrested and jailed in the notorious Evin Prison.

Mr. Babaei was asked by Iran Intelligence Service to have cooperation with them upon Iranians in Belgium and report them to the Intelligence Service in case of any activities against Iran regime and he refused doing it and he convicted as a spy and without any fair trial he sentenced to 10 years in jail.

Ms. Cobra Parsa talks about threat she received from Iran regime as she started seeking help from Iranians media outside of Iran. She must come from a small city to Tehran to visit her husband and guards are treating her nasty.

I did the interview with Ms. Cobra Parsa through my cell phone and recorded it. I always asked Iranians inside Iran for security if they don't want to say their names but she said that she will stand for her husband and have no problem even she knew it is risky. She talked in this excerpt that both of them were doing their PHD in Belgium and she decided for a break to come to Iran and all problems started when they entered Imam Khomeini's Airport. The excerpt is part of a podcast and this excerpt is 7 minutes and 45 seconds.
